
Express Yourself!

What are the **OBJECTS** in the portrait?


Vincent van Gogh loved to paint, so we see:


- A Canvas
- Paintbrushes
- Paints

WHO is in the portrait?

These girls value family, so we see:

 Sisters embracing each other






Frida Kahlo loved the nature of her homeland in Mexico, so we see:

- Banana leaves
 - A monkey

What does the **BACKGROUND** look like?



Joseph Ducreux was happy and easygoing, so we see:


- A smiling face
- A casual pose
- By pointing at the viewer, he interacts with us!

What is the POSE/ACTION in the portrait?

HOW is the portrait drawn?

In this portrait, we see:

- Large blocks of color
- Basic shapes
- Strong, dark lines



Questions to ask when you create your own self-portrait:

WHO do you want in your portrait?
(Beside yourself, of course!)
What type of BACKGROUND will be in your portrait?
What will you be DOING in your portrait?
HOW will your draw your portrait?
